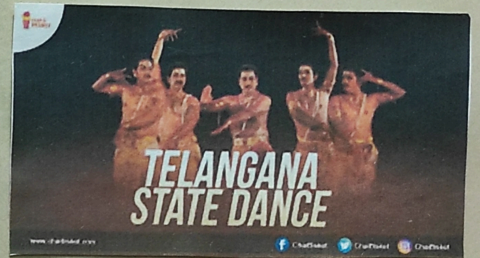


Kuchipudi

Dhimsala

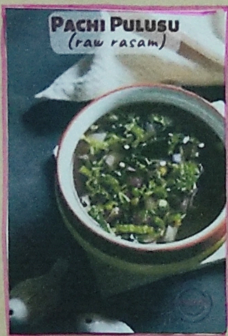

1. Waste Management Policy - **1 News**
Gearring up for comprehensive waste management policy and decentralised waste management in the city, the government is developing 17 transfer stations, pressing into service additional 650 swachh auto tippers, identifying compact transportation points (CTPs), expanding the capacity of effluent treatment plant located in Patancheru, making 10,000 public washrooms operational and building pre-fabricated basti dawakhana. "Seven transfer stations have already been developed, each zone will get 25 autos with 4.5 tonnes capacity which will be deployed in commercial after a review meeting on sanitation held at GHMC head office. The plant to recycle industrial liquid waste in Patancheru, being set up in collaboration with Telangana State Industrial Infrastructure Corporation (TSIIC), would be operational within six months. The zero liquid discharge common effluent treatment plant which can treat 480 kilolitre per day (KLD) of industrial waste, is being expanded to a million litres per day. "Ramky Engineers Engineers Limited said. As per GHMC, 15 CTPs have been setup within two months and an additional 35 CTPs would dot the city.

(1) Free drinking water in Hyderabad from January says KTR.

Municipal Administration and Urban Development Minister RT Rama Rao said the state government's free drinking water supply programme in the city would be formally launched in the first week of January. As per the instructions of Chief Minister K. Chandrababu Naidu, no charges would be collected for consumption of up to 2000 litres in the December bills from consumers he said. To this effect, the MAUD Minister convened a meeting with Hyderabad Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board (HMWSSB) officials here on Saturday. Chief Secretary Somesh Kumar also participated in the meeting. Instructions were issued to the HMWSSB officials to chalk out plans, modalities and arrangements for implementation of the free water supply programme. After the modalities were worked out, the Minister would conduct another meeting in a few days. During the meetings, the Minister also reviewed the drinking water supply in the city. Officials said that since the last few years, the drinking water supply had improved and increased. In tune with the increasing demand, HMWSSB was also enhancing the supply capacity annually. This was mainly possible due to upgrading the existing infrastructure and amenities since the last five years. HMWSSB officials informed that the necessary arrangements were being laid to ensure

Covid -19

Telangana :- Vaccination will be done at all government health facilities such as primary health centres, district hospitals and teaching facilities. When contacted, State Principal Health, Medical and Family Welfare Secretary Syed Ali Murtuza Rizvi said they were following the centres guidelines for the vaccination programme. Telangana is in the process of creating the required infrastructure for administering COVID-19 vaccine initially to about 80 lakh people, including front-line workers, once the preventive medicine is available for the state. Official sources said on Wednesday Training programmes for almost 10,000 vaccinators were underway and storage facilities for the doses being set up at strategic locations. Even if one vaccinator administers 100 people a day, on an average 10,000 vaccinators can vaccinate 80 lakh people in eight or ten days, a health department official told. The official further said as of now there was no approved vaccine for COVID-19 in the country and preparations were being made to be ready for administering it as and when available. Telangana mulls reopening of schools for 120 days
Hydrabad: Plans are afoot to reopen schools in the state for 120 days for the academic year is yet to be finalised by the state govt during a series of meetings conducted recently by the Education department, attended by authorities of welfare schools a majority were inclined for the reopening of school for 120 days starting from December. Not just day schools, but plans are also to reopen residential schools under various welfare societies. Initially, Physical classwork will be for students of classes IX & X. All schools will have to strictly adhere to covid-19 precautionary measures issued by the Union and state governments. About 120 days will suffice to cover Imp topics and bridge classed can be held later. So, there is a consensus that schools should reopen for 120 days from December or at least from January. We have sent the minutes of the meeting on the Covid situation and suggestions from the Health department, the government will take a decision on schools reopening an official said. All educational institutions have been closed since March on account of the pandemic. Government schools have launched online digital classes through T-SAT Network channel and Soordashan from September 1, while private schools have been conducting online classes since June. Meanwhile, the state Council of Educational Research and Training under the school Education department has released a subject-wise alternate academic calendar with activity / project based instructions syllabus for classes I to X.
