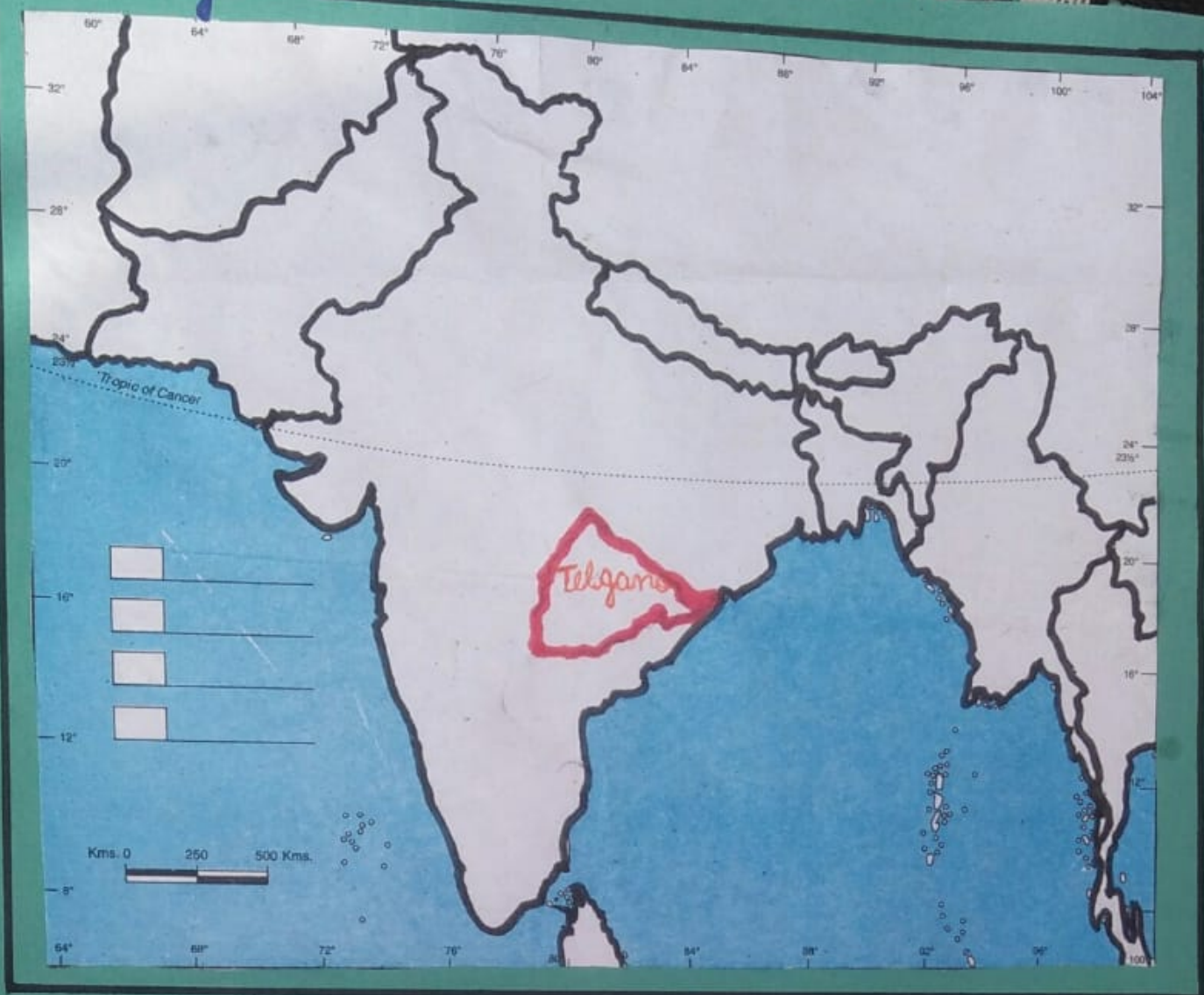

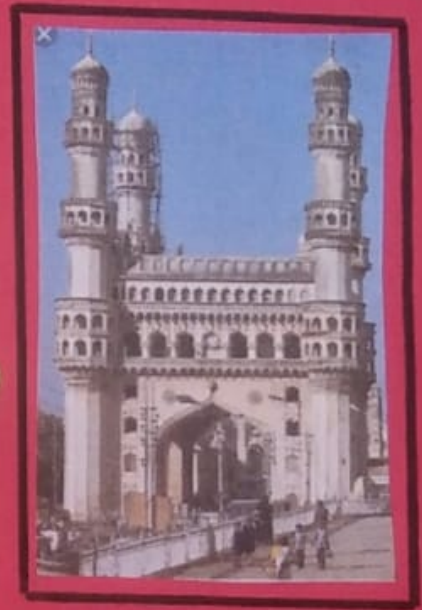

The area of what is now Telangana constituted the north-central and northeastern portions of Andhra Pradesh for almost 6 decades, but on June 2, 2014, that territory was called off to form a separate state. The capital of both Telangana and Andhra Pradesh is Hyderabad in western-central Telangana.

Language of Telangana...

Telugu one of classical languages of India is the official language of Telangana and Urdu is second official language. About 77% of population of Telangana speak Telugu and 12% speak Urdu. Before 1948, Urdu was official language of Hyderabad state and due to lack of Telugu-language educational institutions, Urdu was language of educational elite of Telangana.

Year of Formation...

After several years of protest and agitation, the central govt. under the United Progressive Alliance Andhra Pradesh State and on 7 February 2014, the Union Cabinet of Telangana cleared the bill for the creation of Telangana. On **2 June 2014** Telangana was created.



Weather...

Telangana is a semi-arid area and has a predominantly hot and dry climate. Summers start in March, and peak in May with average high temperature in 42°C . The monsoon begins in June and lasts until September with about 755 mm of precipitation.

Mohammad Azharuddin famous cricketer and captain of Indian cricket team was born in Hyderabad on 8 Feb, 1963.

Zakir Hussain was an Indian economist and politician who served as 3rd President of India was born in Hyderabad (now in Telangana).



Anathuni Lakshakar Rao was a Telangana guerrilla leader and also considered foremost authority of Telugu language. He was an Indian freedom fighter.



Shalima Azmi popular actress, theatre and TV artist was born in Hyderabad city of then Hyderabad state on 18 Sept 1952.



Sanamizha Parulekar tennis player although born in Mumbai on 15 Nov 1986, resides in Hyderabad. She was the 1st Indian woman to win WTA title.

Charminar

Chowmahalla Palace

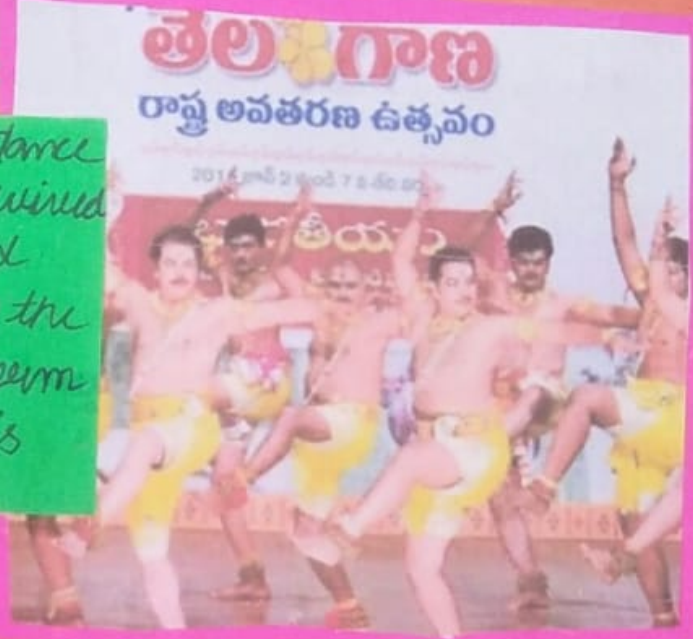
Spacious courtyards, impeccable arch and unending tourist footfall at Chowmahalla Palace in Hyderabad promise it all.

Important dance ..

Kuini Sivatandaram is an ancient dance from Telangana which has been revived in recent times. It originated and prospered in Telangana during the Kakatiya dynasty. It is a dance form usually performed by males. It is called 'Dance of Warriors'.



Dhimsala is a ritual dance form that is performed primarily by lepra caste women in India. A group of 15-20 women form a circle and dance praising the deity for the welfare of their domestic life.

Kuchipudi is one of the 8 major Indian classical dances. It originated in a village named Kuchipudi in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Hypocritical: The Telangana recognized Schools Managements Association (TRSMA) on Saturday demanded that the state release the academic calendar with assessments elimination dates and extended the academic year 2020-21 till July 2021.

The state should make it mandatory for students to attend 120 days of physical classes after re-opening the schools to get promoted to next class. "At present, the school education system is dilapidated due to pandemic. To bring school education back on track, the state should release the academic calendar give instructions to ensure that all students attend online or TSAT classes to minimize the importance of students attending physical classes, they said that not many are able to attend online or digital classes due to various reasons including lack of devices, internet connectivity. "The current academic year should be extended at least till July so that students get to attend at classes physically for 3 to 4 months. This is necessary for few students get to attend classes physically on class reunions or get important topics and classes for 120 days, he/she should not be promoted to next class," said Y Shekhar Rao. President, TRSMA. The school management of secondary school should announce the dates. They, however, said SSC exams should not be held in May or June like every year and added that students should be given an additional time.

TELANGANA GOVT. LAUNCHES WEBSITES FOR REGISTERING Non-Agricultural LAND...



The registration process for non-agricultural properties will be resumed in Telangana from Monday, December 14. The one-stop portal for registration of all properties in the state had a soft launch on Friday and is operational.

The website registration.telangana.gov.in can be used for booking slots with date and time for non-agricultural property registration.

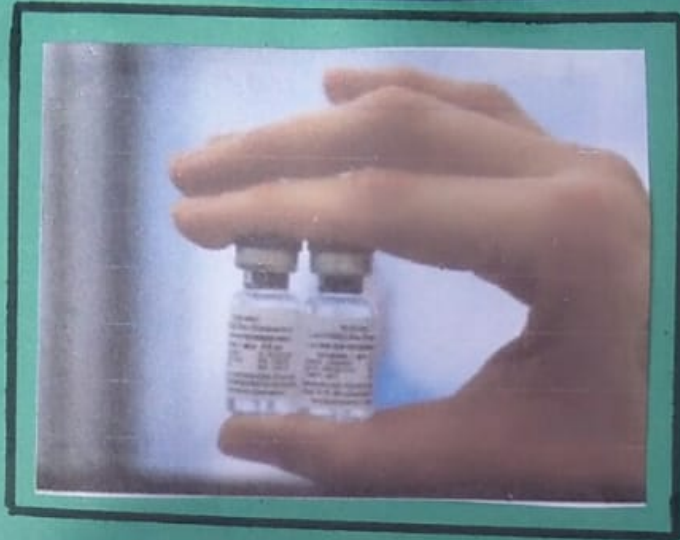
The service can also be availed at muna centres for Rs 200. Though each sub-registration office can be allotted 100 slots per day, for now only 24 slots per day are being allowed. The no. of slots will be increased with the increase in demand, informed the Telangana. The slots can be used for sale, purchase, gift deeds, mortgages and other services.

those intending to use the satellite's services will require their Telangana property identification No (PTIN) or Property Tax Andhra No (PTIN). Those who do not have these panchnamts, municipalities, municipal corporations, for these 2 weeks, as directed by Telangana High Court.

For builders and real estate developers a separate window has been created enabling them to upload new properties in bulk. So far, 451 builders and developers details of 93,874 properties. Once a slot is booked through online payment or by paying challans on SBTs details on location of sub-registrar office will be sent via SMS.

All land registration processes were put on hold in Telangana on Sep 8, with TRS govt. rollout of Dharani, a one-stop portal for land transfer update and registration. However, the initiative ran into trouble over data collection and Telangana High Court directed the state and registration dept. to not collect details such as dadhar and caste details of land buyers and sellers. The portal for registering non-agricultural lands was meant to be part of Dharani portal. The merger has been deferred due to the court case, said chief secretary Somesh Kumar while speaking to media on Telangana High Court's ruling on subject, reported the New Indian Express.

Coronavirus | Telangana forms 4 committees for Covid-19 vaccination.

Vaccine Introduction is likely to span over an year.

The Telangana government has constituted 4 committees for planning, execution, supervision and monitoring of the COVID-19 vaccination programme in the state.

According to the orders issued on Friday, the committees are state steering committee, state steering committee, state task force, district task force and Mandal task force. Principal Secretary of State Health and Family Health and Family Welfare department Syed Ali Musataza Rizvi said that preparations for the possible introduction of the vaccine had begun.

“It is anticipated that initially the supply of vaccine will be limited in a view of a huge demand, hence, prioritisation of high risk groups will need to be done for vaccination and subsequently other groups will be included for vaccination.” Mr. Rizvi said in order.

Stating that the vaccine introduction was likely to span over an year with multiple groups being included sequentially starting from Health care workers, he said.

It was important to create strong advisory and implementation mechanism at state, district and Mandal level to guide the process of Covid-19 vaccine introduction while ensuring minimal disruption of other routine health care services, including routine immunisation, he said.

Telangana High Court adjourns pleas on Centre's maize policy.

Hyderabad. A two-judge Bench of the Telangana High Court comprising chief justice Raghunatha Singh Chaudhri and justice Vijayasen Reddy on Monday adjourned a batch of about 11 cases on the Centre's policy on import of maize from December 30. Several marketing and others questioned the decision of govt. in permitting corn to be imported without a use-only licence. Public interest litigation cases were also filed against the inaction of govt. and complaining about different departments taking opposite stands.

No Interim relief for GS oils Ajay Mahamuni

Justice Challa Kodana Rom of high court on Monday dismissed a writ plea filed by Ajay Mahamuni of GS oils to quash a stopout circular issued against him restraining him from travelling abroad. He contended that he had to solemnise his daughter's marriage in London and has already booked his return ticket for December 18. The court, denying the interim relief, held that as the petitioner had defaulted bonds of hundreds of crores, he cannot be allowed to travel abroad. Justice Kodandaram said, protecting the interest of depositors and the banks would be of paramount importance.

Notices Issued in Medical Negligence Case.

Justice Naureen Rao of the High Court on Monday issued notices to the concerned in a writ plea dealing with medical negligence.

The petitioner last saw her daughter in the ICU on March 24, and on March 28, Zella's body was handed over to her mother. She further alleged that the police were in connivance with hospital authorities as they were not taking any action despite her filing a complaint with the station House officer Lonjagutta. The judge adjourned the matter by 3 weeks.
